I’m watching the NCAA basketball tournament, as I write these words. I am a big fan, although picking winners has not gone so well!

Many commentators have tried to identify the “magic” of March Madness. Some say it’s the possibility of the underdog winning, even though the true underdogs never win the whole thing. Some say it’s that it is a true playoff, as opposed to the college football system. While both of those concepts are true, I believe the real magic of the tournament is simple elimination. You lose, and you go home – season over.

That kind of thinking dominates modern culture. Reality TV is a good example. Survivor has one winner, as others are “voted off the island”. The bachelor can only pick one woman. Many of our so-called reality shows are based on elimination, even more than they are based on reality! How many of us prove our merit in life by going off to a deserted island? And who gets to date 25 women at one time? This is not reality!

This elimination thinking poses a challenge for Christianity, because God’s system is the exact opposite. Nobody gets voted off God’s island! Elimination thinking plays into our human sinfulness. We want to believe that we are better than everybody else, even if it means I take a place in God’s kingdom at your expense. But there is a place for everyone in the family of God.

It’s readily obvious that there are differences between people. God gave us all gifts, but we have different gifts. And in the ways that the world looks at people, some folks look strong, and some look weak. Some people are Duke and Kansas, while others are Hampton and Bucknell. But in God’s world, they are all in the tournament! And in God’s kingdom, they will all be there at the end.

St. Paul writes, in First Corinthians 1, “God chose the foolish things of the world to shame the wise; God chose the weak things of the world to shame the strong.”
