Reach out to those in need

I can't afford my medication if I pay my electric bill. My child needs to go to the dentist but I can't afford it. My unemployment covers my bills but I don't have money for food. If you find yourself in any of these situations My Brother's Keeper is here to help. My Brother's Keeper is a member-to-member ministry. We are here to assist with financial, emotional, or spiritual needs. It's not just about money, though often we can help with that, it's also about helping our members find help. Since we started we have been able to help many families. If you could use some help contact Pastor Paul. Your situation will be kept confidential. For those who have been donating to My Brother's Keeper we want to say thank you. Your generosity is making it possible for this congregation to take care of one another and live out our call to be our brother's keeper.

Prayer is a ministry! We are called to pray for one another. Yes, we are even told by Jesus to pray for our enemies! If you're like me, there are times when my prayer life is a little lacking. There are times when the business of life drives out my prayer time. With that in mind, we're going to try to do something about our prayer lives.

The Wednesday night study group called Scripture Life and Me (S.L.A.M.) along with the Women's Thursday Bible Study group is participating in a ministry called Prayer Partners.

This ministry will seek to deepen our prayer lives and build relationships within the groups. Each person will fill out a personal profile.
