I love Advent! I enjoy the planning and the preparation and yes, the waiting for the coming Christ. I add an extra devotional during the Advent season and avoid as much of the Christmas stuff as I can until the night of December 24th. OK, I know that probably makes me eccentric in many of your eyes but it's me. I love the

anticipation.

Part of that anticipation comes from the mid-week Advent services. This year we are focusing specifically on the Biblical Christmas preparation by looking at Luke 1. We all know the telling of the birth of the Christ child in Luke 2 with its soaring phrases such as "For unto you is born this day..." and "Glory to God in the highest...". But do we remember that the great *Magnificat* and Zechariah's song, the *Benedictus*, both come from Luke 1? For centuries the former has served as the core of Evening Prayer for the Church (Vespers) while the latter has done the same for Morning Prayer (Matins).

Our study of this chapter will be aided by our seventh and eighth grade catechism classes. They have looked at the four separate narratives of the chapter and have devised some questions. Those questions and my answers to them will form the basis of the mid-week services' reflection. It will be part sermon, part Bible study and all worship. The service will be framed by Advent hymns and centered in the Gospel's pronouncement, reflection, and then response of praise using a new, hymnic version of the *Magnificat* which we will learn by singing each week. I pray you will be able and indeed eager to join your brothers and sisters in Christ and take time to prepare your hearts for the joyous festival to come.

May the anticipatory excitement and joy of the Advent season be yours,


