#### **GRACE FORUMS**

Can we talk? That's the way Joan Rivers began her comedy routines. It's also a good way to introduce congregation-wide conversations that we're calling "Grace Forums". There are two issues for which

decisions are coming up, and these issues involve the life of our entire congregation. So I am inviting you into the conversation. I'll be leading four of these "Grace Forums", and at each one we will discuss these two issues.

- Structural changes in our decision-making process. This year a task force has been working hard to make our church councils and committees more effective. One key part of their proposal is lowering the number of church council members (currently 36, larger than any other congregation we have found to date). Let's talk about it! When you come to a forum, you'll hear about the proposal and reasons for change, and you will have a chance to ask questions and give feedback.
- 2) Age of first communion. Currently our congregation welcomes children to receive communion when they are in fifth grade. Our Worship Committee is proposing to lower this age to second grade. Let's talk about it! At the forums, we'll share what the Bible says about communion, and what Martin Luther teaches in the Small Catechism (the book that guides Lutheran teaching and practice).

#### (Pastor's message continued.)

So let's talk about it! We've arranged the forum schedule with intentional variety, so that there's one on Sunday, one during the daytime, and a couple in the evening - so that many of you can attend! Each forum will discuss the same material, so you only have to come to one. Forums will be held:

> Wednesday, July 14, 2:00 p.m. (in the lounge) Wednesday, July 14, 7:00 p.m. (in the lounge) Sunday, July 18, 9:00 a.m. (during Sunday School, in the dining room. Monday, July 19, 7:00 p.m. (in the lounge)
