If we stop coming to worship because the pastor isn't here then who is it we are really worshiping? Jesus is still here! His promise is that he will never leave us.

In God's perfect time we will get a new senior pastor. Until that time I challenge each of us to continue in service, fellowship and worship. Remember, Jesus is still with us and always will be, until the end of the age.




