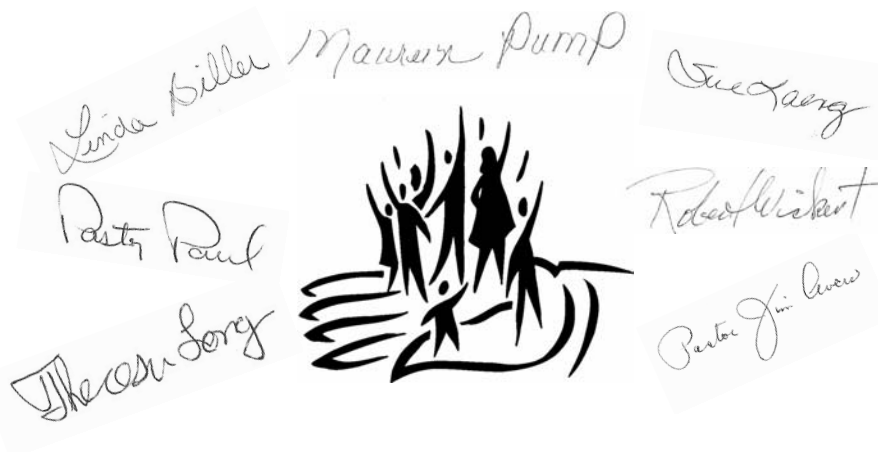

GOD HAS THE LAST LAUGH

Christ is risen! The Easter message that Christ is risen from the dead brings good news for all people.

We live in a world that is filled with messages of death, and we ourselves are often surrounded by death. We know that our human bodies are not permanent, that our flesh will fail us. At a certain age, even while we are alive we recognize that our bodies are already beginning to fail.

And our sin is death. We know that we are sinners. The Bible teaches us that the penalty for sin is death. And there is nothing (without Jesus) that we can do to remove this penalty.

“I can’t afford my medication if I pay my electric bill...”

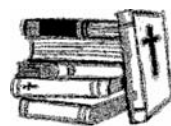
“My child needs to go to the dentist, but I can’t afford it...”

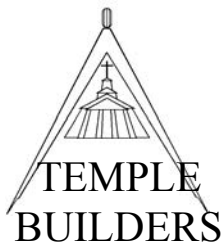

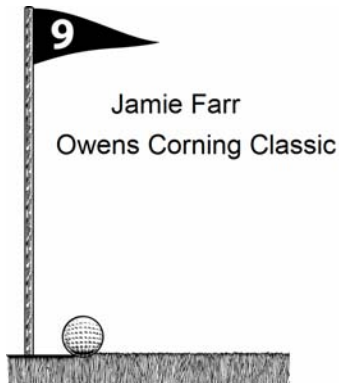
out to those who don’t yet know Christ. This study will help us focus on how we can demonstrate our faith to others. Please join this discussion with Christine Schneider Smith facilitating.

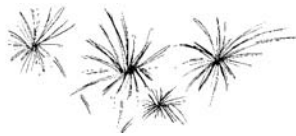

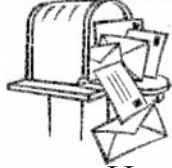
