Use this fun activity, adapted from Group's *Hands-On Bible*, to show how God helps us solve problems:

Break graham crackers into fourths and spread marshmallow creme on one side of each section. Stack the crackers on top of each other, using the creme as cement. Line up several stacks to form a wall. Say: "Let's shout at our wall as loudly as we can." Afterward, ask what happened. Say: "That's right—nothing! It isn't easy to bring down a wall with just noise, but God did it. God is awesome!" As you eat each section of the wall, discuss times when you need God's power. Close in prayer, asking God to help you with all your problems and challenges.


