BIBLE BASICS

Only a few brave souls have ever admitted this to me, but I think they represent a more common feeling: “I can’t come to Bible study, because I don’t know enough about the Bible”. And while on the surface that seems weird, I get it! There is a fear of looking bad, perhaps, and a fear of not being able to keep up. And yet, Bible study is good and important in the Christian life; we don’t want people to stay away!

So here is a Bible study that is designed for the person who thinks they’re not ready for Bible study! I am teaching a study this fall called, “Bible Basics”. And that’s exactly what it is! We’ll start at the very beginning, figuring out how to find your way through this book that can be over 1000 pages. We’ll talk about why there are two testaments, why there are different books of the Bible. We’ll talk about Jesus, which is the most important message of our holy book. My goal is to give you a foundation of knowledge about the Bible, and take away the “fear factor”. Second goal: help you to become comfortable with the Bible enough so that you will read it, and perhaps even join another study group!

You are invited! We meet on Tuesday evenings, at 7:00 p.m. in the church lounge, beginning on September 14. I would love to see you in this study! This can be a big step forward in your faithful walk with Jesus.

CONFIRMATION

A new season of Confirmation is about to begin! Confirmation is our church's ministry with 7th- and 8th- graders. We gather on Wednesday evenings to learn about Jesus and his love, through the stories of the Bible and Martin Luther's "Small Catechism". We learn, we laugh, we pray, we play. We spend some time each week in "large group" teaching sessions, and also in "small groups" where the focus is on relationships, caring, and lesson review. We even spend a weekend together at Camp Mowana (near Mansfield). And at the end of two years, each young person has the opportunity to affirm their faith in Jesus with the whole church, in the Service of Confirmation.

Incoming 7th-graders are receiving a letter inviting them to participate in Confirmation. If you know a 7th-grader who didn't get an invitation, contact the church office and we'll make sure to send one. That invitation letter also tells about the parent information meeting that will be held on Thursday, September 2 at 7:30 p.m. in the church lounge.

Confirmation meets every Wednesday from 7:30 p.m. until 8:45 p.m. First night of Confirmation for this new year is on September 8.
